PRESS RELEASE

The Greater Warren County Drug Task Force and the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) announce the indictment of the following individual:

Ahmed Ghazi
3766 Armada Court
Beavercreek, Ohio
DOB: 1/7/82

Charges: (2) Counts of Trafficking in Drugs (Methamphetamine)
(2) Counts of Illegal Assembly of Chemicals

Mr. Ghazi is the co-owner of the Sunoco Convenience store at I-75 and State Route 63 in Monroe. He was involved in selling methamphetamine and pseudoephedrine to an undercover officer for several months. Last week, over 45,000 dosage units of pseudoephedrine were seized at the defendant's residence in Greene County and at the convenience store in Monroe.

The amount of pseudoephedrine seized would produce approximately 2 kilos of methamphetamine, with an ultimate street value of about \$250,000.

Today, March 19th. at 2:00 P.M. a press conference will be held at the Warren County Sheriff's Office, 550 Justice Drive, Lebanon, Ohio. The seized pseudoephedrine will be on display during the press conference.
